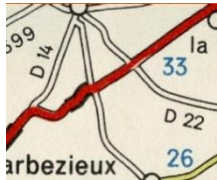
Regulations



1. MAP READING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1 Plot the shortest route from start to lunch to finish on white and yellow roads.
- 1.2 Prefer white roads which will give you almost the perfect Tulip Rallye feeling.
- 1.3 Minimise the use of yellow roads.
- 1.4 Do not use red roads, if not specifically instructed otherwise.
- 1.5 It is permitted to cross red roads.
- 1.6 Do not use roads which are blocked with an "X".
- 1.7 Any road or road section can only be used once on any single day.

Example:



It is permitted to cross a red road



Permitted to cross the red road in N-S / S-N direction, **NOT** in E-W / W-E direction



The red road may **NOT** be crossed here



2. THE COMPETITION

- 2.1 Every day at 8:01 hrs. all teams will receive the 1-page road book for the day.
- 2.2 The stage needs to be completed by 20:00 hrs. on the same day and the correct answer returned via e-mail.
- 2.3 On Wednesday there will be an additional evening stage starting at 20:01 hrs., tasks to be completed by 22:00 hrs. on the same day. This Leg will have an additional outcome in the results.
- 2.4 Crews which do not return solutions or with a delay, will not receive any points for that day.
- 2.5 In order to come to the correct solution, a varying control mechanism is used per day, which will be explained on the map fragment.
- 2.6 The correct solution could be a number, a word or a letter.
- 2.7 Per day the sent solutions will be rewarded with 1 point (correct route) or 0 points (wrong route).
- 2.8 The day after each Leg, the route explanation and the results will be published on the website.
- 2.9 On Saturday evening at 22:00 hrs. the winner will be published on the website.

3. WINNERS – PRIZE GIVING

- 3.1 The crew with the highest number of points will be the overall winner.
- 3.2 In case of ex aequo, the crew that sends in the correct solution first on Saturday is the winner.
- 3.3 The winner will receive the prize during the festive prize giving on 31 October in Chateau St. Gerlach.

4. PROTEST

- 4.1 Protests can be submitted, if signed by the driver. Since we have no drivers on this navigation-only event, no protests can be submitted.
- 4.2 Questions can be posed to the organisation Committee by email. The committee reserves the right to answer or not to answer the questions on the following morning.
